Representative Cases

- Represented agency in appeal on two consolidated claims based on the allegation that language in letters was false or misleading and successfully affirmed dismissal at the Seventh Circuit on grounds that consumers lacked Article III standing because they failed to present any evidence of claimed harm.
- Obtained opinion from the Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals affirming the district court's order dismissing the plaintiff's FDCPA claims on the grounds that the challenged letter was not unfair or deceptive and the interest sought was permitted.
- Obtained opinion affirming the district court's order dismissing the plaintiff's FDCPA claims and holding as a matter of first impression that a materiality standard applies to claims of deception under the FDCPA; *Hill*, 888 F.3d 343 (8th Cir. 2018).

 interest sought was permitted.
- Obtained decision affirming summary judgment in favor of attorney defendants because the plaintiff
 could not produce evidence to prove that but for the attorneys' alleged malpractice, the plaintiff
 would have obtained a more favorable result in the underlying real estate transaction.
- Obtained order dismissing a plaintiff's medical malpractice claims because the complaint failed to allege compensable damages.
- Obtained order dismissing a plaintiff's complaint for failure to meet basic pleading requirements under Minn. R. Civ. P. 8.01.
- The Minnesota Supreme Court granted immunity to the provider under the Minnesota Commitment Treatment Act holding that the Act applied to a provider's good-faith actions not to admit a patient seeking voluntary admission; *Binkley*, 877 N.W.2d 547 (Minn. 2016).

 misrepresentation must be "material" to be a violation.

 with FDCPA language, are not taken "in connection with the collection of any debt" and therefore not
 subject to the FDCPA.
